### Silent Reading Together

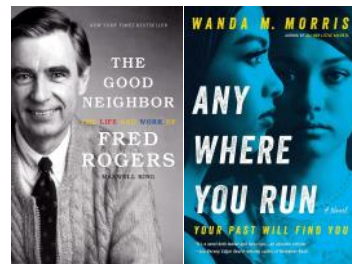
**Second Sunday, August 11th 2:00-4:00**

### Deviled Egg Cook-Off

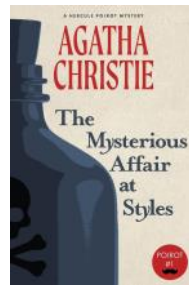
**Sunday, August 18th, 2:00**
